STRENGTHS

Capricorn Rhodes Grass is a perennial, summer growing, diploid grass that is a fine leaf Katambora type with a superb stem to leaf ratio.

PASTURE TYPE AND USE

With its aggressive growth habits, Capricorn is a highly stoloniferous variety selected for high quality forage and hay production as well as amenity, revegetation and soil conservation purposes.

WHERE IT GROWS

Rainfall: 500 millimetres+.

Soils: A salt tolerant variety, Capricorn is a broadly adapted variety performing in varying soil textures and fertility including infertile sands and loams.

Temperature: Capricorn is drought tolerant and is moderately tolerant to frosts.
